Pursuant to Public Utilities (PU) Code Section 311 (g), draft resolutions are available for public comments. Comments should be focused on factual, legal, and/or technical errors in the draft resolutions. Comments must be limited to five pages in length and shall include a subject index listing the recommendations to the draft resolutions, a table of authorities, and an appendix setting forth the proposed revised findings and ordering paragraphs. PU Code Section 311(g) (1) requires that draft resolutions be served on all parties and subject to at least 30 days public review and comment prior to a vote of the Commission.

Comments must be submitted no later than 5:00 pm on September 5, 2006.

Late-filed comments will ordinarily be rejected. However, in extraordinary circumstances, a request for leave to submit comments late may be filed together with proposed comments. An accompanying declaration under penalty of perjury shall be submitted setting forth all the reasons for the late submission.
