TO: PARTIES TO DRAFT RESOLUTION EGPB-6

Enclosed is Draft Resolution EGPB-6 of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division addressing the Final Audit Report of Etiwanda Generating Station. It will be on the agenda at the May 15, 2008 Commission meeting. The Commission may then vote on this Resolution or it may postpone a vote until later. The actual audit report will not be available on the website unless and until the Commission makes it public at the May 15, 2008 meeting.

When the Commission votes on a Draft Resolution, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend, modify or set it aside and prepare a different Resolution. Only when the Commission acts does the Resolution become binding on the parties.

You may file comments on this Resolution by Wednesday, April 30, 2008, with reply comments sent no later than Wednesday, May 8, 2008. Comments shall be limited to five pages in length plus a subject index listing the recommended changes to the Draft Resolution, a table of authorities and an appendix setting forth the proposed findings and ordering paragraphs. It shall focus on factual, legal or technical errors in the proposed Draft Resolution.
