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Energy Division held a workshop in this proceeding via WebEx and in San Francisco on Friday, July 10, 2009. Due to technical difficulties, the WebEx feature did not function, and those that had logged in were unable to participate. The workshop will generally address the 2010 guides and templates used for Resource Adequacy compliance, and parties are encouraged to assemble questions related to the mechanics of the filings and bring them to the workshop so Energy Division can answer them. Compliance filing procedures in 2010 will be very similar to 2009, but those staff that are new to the Resource Adequacy filing process are strongly encouraged to participate. Energy Division will also devote time in this workshop to discussing the use of the Load Impact Protocols as Qualifying Capacity counting conventions for Demand Response resources.

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The California Energy Commission's (CEC) 2009 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) Committee, in conjunction with representatives of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the California Independent System Operator (CAISO), will conduct a workshop to present the joint energy agency proposal on implementation of once-through cooling (OTC) mitigation through energy infrastructure planning and procurement. This proposal was submitted to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) for their use in developing a policy to mitigate harm from OTC. The SWRCB's draft OTC policy was released on June 30, 2009. The purpose of the workshop is to obtain feedback from stakeholders about the joint energy agency proposal and explore implementation details related to resource planning, procurement, generation permitting, and transmission planning processes.
