SB 412 authorizes the CPUC, in consultation with the California Air Resources Board (ARB), to determine eligible technologies for the Self Generation Incentive Program (SGIP) based on the requirement that they "achieve reductions of greenhouse gas emissions pursuant to the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006."
