Section 252 provides that incumbent local exchange carriers must enter into interconnection agreements with other telecommunications carriers. Section 252 of the Act provides specific standards for the approval of these agreements by the state regulatory commission. Under this section of the Act a state commission may assist negotiating parties in reaching agreements through mediation and/or compulsory arbitration.
