The 33% RPS Calculator was developed by Energy and Environmental Economics, Inc. (E3), in consultation with Energy Division staff, to develop portfolios of resources that achieve a 33% RPS in 2020, as inputs to the utilities' system plans in the 2010 Long-Term Procurement Proceeding. The final Calculator, which was used to develop the required RPS scenarios released in the December 3, 2010 Scoping Memo, is available on the 2010 LTPP website, [http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/PUC/energy/Procurement/LTPP/ltp\\_history.htm](http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/PUC/energy/Procurement/LTPP/ltp_history.htm). The purpose of this training is to educate parties about the updated Calculator's functioning and flexibility, so that parties can test alternate inputs and assumptions, identify key variables that cause a significant change in the resources chosen to meet the RPS goal and, if desired, use the Calculator to develop alternate scenarios for consideration in the proceeding.
