Draft Resolution ALJ-274 delegates specified authority to the Consumer Protection and Safety Division Staff, or such other Staff as may be designated by the Executive Director, to issue citations to all gas corporations to enforce compliance with General Order (GO) 112-E. GO 112-E contains specific rules governing the design, construction, testing, maintenance, and operation of utility gas gathering, transmission, and distribution pipeline systems and supplements compliance with the federal standards set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Parts 190, 191, 192, 193, and 199.
