NOTICE OF RESOLUTION TO DISCLOSE INVESTIGATIVE RECORDS

Draft Resolution L-328 authorizes disclosure of Commission Consumer Protection and Safety Division (Railroad Operations Safety Branch) records pursuant to a subpoena by Union Pacific Railroad (Union Pacific). The subpoena seeks disclosure of Commission staff investigative records relating to an incident on August 1, 2003, in which Mr. Roger Stabler, a switch foreman employed by Union Pacific, was injured while riding on the side of a remote control locomotive. The injury occurred on Union Pacific's Roseville Service Unit, Martinez Subdivision, when an automatic gate at the Valero Refinery failed to open fully.
