Summary: On March 26, 2007, Kerry Hattevik, Senior Manager of Regulatory Affairs for the West, Mirant California, LLC, Mirant Delta, LLC and Mirant Potrero, LLC (Mirant) met with Nancy Ryan, advisor to Pres. Peevey in San Francisco.
