The fee levels set by this resolution for passenger vehicle operators, vessel operators, commercial air operators and pipeline corporations are unchanged from the fee levels set for fiscal year 2006-07. The fee level set for the railroad corporations reflect a \$739,000 increase from the level set for fiscal year 2006-07 due to a 2007-08 budget augmentation of \$705,000 and 7.0 positions for Chapter 885, Statutes of 2006 (AB 1935, Bermudez), which requires more frequent railroad safety inspections.
