NOTICE OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION RECORDS

Draft Resolution L-355 authorizes disclosure of records related to the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Consumer Protection and Safety Division’s investigation of a train-automobile collision that occurred on June 28, 2007, near the intersection of E. Meadow Drive and Alma Street in Palo Alto, California. Draft Resolution L-355 will be on the agenda at the Commission’s January 10, 2008, meeting. The Commission may then vote on the resolution or it may postpone a vote until later. The Commission may adopt all or part of L-355, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution.

On December 11, 2007, the draft resolution was circulated to the Resolution L-355 service list, pursuant to California Public Utilities Code § 311(g) and Rule 14.2(c)(2) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure.
