NOTICE OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION RECORDS

Draft Resolution L-367 authorizes disclosure of records related to the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Consumer Protection and Safety Division’s investigation of a November 15, 2007, incident when a man was struck by a train while crossing the railroad tracks near the Berkeley Amtrak Station.

Draft Resolution L-367 will be on the agenda at the Commission’s September 4, 2008 meeting. The Commission may then vote on the resolution or it may postpone a vote until later. The Commission may adopt all or part of L-367, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution.

On August 5, 2008, the draft resolution was circulated to the Resolution L-367 service list, pursuant to California Public Utilities Code § 311(g) and Rule 14.2(c)(2) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure. Comments shall focus on factual, legal or technical error in the draft resolution, and reply comments shall be limited to identifying misrepresentations of law and fact contained in the comments of other parties.
