ORDER CORRECTING ERROR IN DECISION 09-05-025

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision (D.) 09-05-025 dated May 21, 2009, contained several typographical errors. All of these errors incorrectly identify the decision which adopted a previous ratemaking settlement. All of the corrected references should be to D. 02-07-041.

Therefore, pursuant to Resolution A-4661 and Rule 16.5 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, which provides for the correction of obvious typographical errors or omissions in a Commission decision.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The first sentence in the first paragraph at Section 4.1 at page 5 is corrected to read in part: "Bear Valley is subject to an existing settlement agreement adopted in D.02-07-041 . . ."
2. The citation in the last paragraph at Section 4.1 at page 5 is corrected to read: "(See, D.02-07-041, Finding of Fact 5, and Ordering Paragraph 3.)"
3. Conclusion of Law 2 is corrected to read:
"Before August 31, 2011, Bear Valley may only recover the incurred costs of the Shell Agreement for energy delivered to retail customers subject to the settlement agreement as adopted in D.02-07-041."

4. Conclusion of Law 3 is corrected to read:

“The settlement adopted in D.02-07-041 is not modified or altered by this decision.”

5. Ordering Paragraph 1 is corrected to read:

“For energy delivered to retail customers, Golden State Water Company’s Bear Valley Electric Service Division (Bear Valley) may recover the actual costs of the Power Purchase Agreement (agreement), with Shell Energy North America (US) L.P. (Shell) incurred before August 31, 2011, subject to the existing settlement agreement adopted in Decision 02-07-041.”

6. Application 08-08-021 is closed.

This order is effective today.
