**DECISION CLOSING DOCKET ON COMMISSION'S OWN MOTION**

Decision (D.) 09-02-015 approved a settlement between NextG Networks of California, Inc. (NextG) and the Commission's Consumer Protection and Safety Division. A condition of the settlement was that no later than June 30, 2009, NextG would pay to the General Fund of the State of California the sum of \$100,000. On June 25, 2009, NextG made the required payment. No other action in this docket is anticipated. Accordingly, the docket should be closed.

**Waiver of Comment Period**

This is an uncontested matter in which the decision grants the relief requested. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 311(g)(2) of the Public Utilities Code and Rule 14.6(c)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment is waived.

John A. Bohn is the assigned Commissioner and Karl J. Bemesderfer is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

2. No further activity in this docket is anticipated.

This docket should be closed.
