ORDER CORRECTING ERROR

Decision (D.) 09-12-043 awarded intervenor compensation to the Greenlining Institute (Greenlining). It has come to our attention that there was an inadvertent inconsistency between the Greenlining's attorney Thalia Gonzalez' hourly rate adopted in D.09-12-043 and her hourly rate adopted in an earlier decision, D.09-11-031.

In D.09-11-031, the Commission adopted Gonzalez' hourly rate of \$215 for her work in 2008.¹ D.09-12-043, however, adopted her 2008 hourly rate of \$200. The difference between the amount of the intervenor compensation the Commission awarded in D.09-12-043 and the correct amount based on the appropriate rate is \$43.50. Parties were promptly advised of the error.²

Therefore, pursuant to Resolution A-4661, and Rule 16.5 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, which provide for the correction of obvious typographical errors or omissions in a Commission decision.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 09-12-043 is corrected, as follows (corrected information in bold):

1. Paragraph 1 on page 2 should be corrected to read:

This decision awards The Greenlining Institute **\$12,229.51** in compensation for its substantial contributions, on the issue of business office closures, to Decision 08-07-046, which is a decrease of **\$416,983.50** (97% reduction) because the majority of the requested compensation was for activities which the Commission found to be beyond the scope of the proceeding and no order was necessary by the Commission.

2. The second sentence of Paragraph 3 on page 20 should be corrected to read:

Gonzalez has previously established rates before the Commission of \$165 in 2006 in D.07-11-013, \$195 in 2007 in D.08-05-015, **and \$215 in 2008 in D.09-11-031.**

3. The fourth and fifth sentences of Paragraph 3 on pages 20-21 should be deleted.

4. A table on page 22 should be corrected to read in the part related to Thalia Gonzalez' rate:

Thalia Gonzalez	2008	\$215	\$215
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5. The first sentence of Section 7 of the decision, on page 25 should be corrected to read:

As set forth in the table below, we award Greenlining **\$12,229.51.**

6. Information on page 26, related to Thalia Gonzalez, the subsequent subtotal, and the grand award should be corrected to read:

2008-Gonzalez 5.8 hrs @ \$107.50 = \$ 623.50	
Subtotal NOI and Intervenor Compensation Claim	\$1,934.50
GRAND TOTAL OF AWARD	\$12,229.51

7. The first sentence immediately below the table on page 26 should be corrected to read:

We direct SDG&E and SoCalGas to pay Greenlining **\$12,229.51**, as required under § 1807.

8. Finding of Fact 5 should be corrected to read:

5. The total of the reasonable compensation is **\$12,229.51**.

9. Conclusion of Law 2 should be corrected to read:

2. Greenlining should be awarded **\$12,229.51** for its contribution to D.08-07-046.

10. Ordering Paragraph 1 should be corrected to read:

The Greenlining Institute is awarded **\$12,229.51** as compensation for its substantial contributions to Decision 08-07-046.

11. In Appendix to the decision, the “Amount Awarded” column should be corrected to read \$12,229.51, and the advocate information related to Thalia Gonzalez’ hourly rate in 2008 should be corrected to read:
