DECISION GRANTING RELIEF

Southern California Edison Company began service to Complainant on April 24, 2008, placing Complainant on rate schedule GS-2. Complainant disputed the GS-2 determination and insists it should be on the GS-1 rate schedule. Complainant seeks a refund of the difference between the GS-2 rate schedule and the GS-1. Public hearing was held February 26, 2010.

On July 7, 2009, Defendant placed Complainant on the GS-1 rate schedule and offered to refund the difference between the rate schedules starting August 4, 2008, in the amount of \$31.18.

Complainant wants the refund to be computed from the start of service, April 24, 2008. If the refund had been computed from the start of service it would be approximately \$40. We will award \$40.

Assignment of Proceeding

Timothy Alan Simon is the assigned Commissioner and Robert Barnett is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern California Edison Company shall credit Complainant with \$40.
2. The money on deposit with the Commission shall be disbursed to Complainant.
3. Case 09-12-007 is closed.

This order is effective today.
