ORDER CORRECTING ERRORS IN DECISION (D.) 04-12-045

Decision (D.) 04-12-045, issued December 16, 2004, contains various nonsubstantive errors. Accordingly, this decision corrects errors in D.04-12-045. The following corrections correspond to the Microsoft Word document issued in hard copy by the Commission and identified on the Commission's website as a "Word" document.

This is an uncontested matter because it merely corrects errors that could be inferred in the context of the discussion or by referring to the staff's report on the Self Generation Incentive Program. Accordingly, and consistent with Section 311g)(2) of the Public Utilities Code, the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment period is being waived.

Assignment of Proceeding

Michael R. Peevey is the Assigned Commissioner and Kim Malcolm is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The second sentence of the last paragraph on page 6 which begins "As of the effective date..." is modified to remove "for Level 1 wind and solar

projects...” The following sentence is corrected to state “Level 1 solar projects will receive...” The second to the last sentence in the same paragraph is modified to state “Except where otherwise noted in Table 1, we adopt those recommendations of the Working Group...”

2. The table on page 8 is deleted and replaced with the following table:

3. The last sentence of the second full paragraph on page 13 ” is changed to state “...within 90 days of the effective date...” rather than referring to 30 days of the effective date.

4. In the second to last sentence of the second full paragraph on page 15, the due date of “February 15, 2005” is changed to “April 30, 2005.”

5. Ordering Paragraph 4 is changed from “...within 30 days...” to “...within 60 days...”

6. Ordering Paragraph 8, subparagraph, is changed to state “(4) remove the annual parent cap on funding for the California University system, other state and federal agencies, corporations, and all other entities formerly restricted under the cap.”

This order is effective today.
