DECISION CLOSING RULEMAKING PROCEEDING

1. Summary

By this decision, we close the above-captioned Rulemaking 02-01-011. This rulemaking was opened to implement the suspension of “direct access” pursuant to Assembly Bill 1 from the First Extraordinary Session (Ch. 4, First Extraordinary Session 2001) and Decision 01-09-060. The purposes for this proceeding have been satisfied, and there is no reason why the proceeding cannot be closed. An Administrative Law Judge’s Ruling issued on October 1, 2008, provided parties with the opportunity to comment as to whether there is any reason to keep this proceeding open. No party indicated an interest in keeping the proceeding open. Accordingly, R.02-01-011 is closed.

2. Waiver of Comment Period

This is an uncontested matter and grants the relief requested. Accordingly, as provided by Rule 14.6(c) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, we waive the otherwise applicable 30-day public review and comment period for this decision.

3. Assignment of Proceeding

Michael R. Peevey is the assigned Commissioner and Thomas R. Pulsifer is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. By ruling dated October 1, 2008, parties were provided notice and opportunity to comment regarding the disposition of remaining matters pending in this docket and the process planned for closing the proceeding.
2. No party has indicated any reason why this proceeding should remain open.
3. The purposes for which this proceeding was opened have been satisfied.

Conclusions of Law

1. There is no reason for this proceeding to remain open.
2. This proceeding should be closed.

IT IS ORDERED that Rulemaking 02-01-011 is closed.
