**Resolution T-17257. Executive Director Resolution Correcting  
Typographical Errors in Resolution T-17256.**

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On January 4, 2010, it was brought to the attention of Communications Division Staff that Resolution T-17256, issued December 31, 2009, contains typographical errors.

1. In the third sentence of the Background paragraph, "Local Fiber, LLC" should read "Wide Voice, LLC".
2. In the fourth sentence of the Background paragraph, "Resolution T-17288" should read "Resolution T-17228".

To correct these errors, a revised copy Resolution T-17256 is attached.

Resolution A-4661, dated March 9, 1977, states that the Executive Director is authorized to sign, "...on behalf of the Commission, orders involving the correction of typographical and clerical errors, and other obvious, inadvertent errors and omission in the decisions and orders of the Commission." **R E S O L U T I O N**

**Resolution T-17256. Request For Reinstatement of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Held by Wide Voice, LLC. (U-7061-C).**

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**Summary**

This Executive Director Resolution reinstates the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) held by Wide Voice, LLC (U-7061-C).

**Background**

Wide Voice, LLC, was originally licensed to provide limited facilities based and resold local exchange and interexchange service by D.08-02-020. According to our records, the company did not file the 2008 User Fee (due January 15, 2009) report in a timely manner and Resolution T-17228, adopted November 20, 2009, revoked operating authority to several carriers including Wide Voice, LLC, for failure to submit the User Fee. On October 26, 2009, Wide Voice, LLC, submitted its User Fee. Communications Division staff was not aware of this submission until after Resolution T-17228 was adopted.

**Discussion**

The Communications Division recommends that the CPCN be reinstated. Although the User Fee report was not sent to the Commission in a timely manner, it was subsequently provided before Resolution T-17228 was adopted by the Commission. Revocation for this carrier is, therefore, not appropriate.

## Findings

1. Wide Voice, LLC, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Facilities-Based and Resale Local Exchange Services in Pacific Bell, Verizon, Citizens Telephone Company and SureWest Telephone Company and Interexchange Services Statewide in D.08-02-020, dated February 28, 2008.
2. Resolution T-17228 revoked the company's operating authority for failure to submit the User Fee report in a timely manner.
3. The company submitted its User Fee on October 26, 2009 before Resolution T-17228 became effective.
4. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was revoked as CD was not aware of the User Fee submission.
5. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be reinstated.

### **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:**

1. Wide Voice, LLC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is reinstated.
2. Utility Identification Number U-7061-C is reissued to the company.
3. Wide Voice, LLC, is reminded to be more timely in following its regulatory deadlines to avoid revocation and penalty actions.

This Resolution is effective today.
