RESOLUTION T-16620. VOLUNTARY REVOCATION OF GENS  
TELESIS INTERNATIONAL, INC. (U-5905-C). CERTIFICATE OF  
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.

**SUMMARY**

This resolution revokes, at the request of Gens Telesis International, Inc., its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN).

**BACKGROUND**

Gens Telesis International, Inc. was certificated by the Commission as a non-dominant interexchange carrier (A.97-10-036/D.97-11-089). Gens Telesis International, Inc. was detariffed in its original decision.

Gens Telesis International, Inc. has stated by letter to the Commission that it no longer has any customers and that it requests revocation of its CPCN.

**DISCUSSION**

Gens Telesis International, Inc. (U-5905-C) has sent a letter dated March 28, 2001 to the Commission requesting revocation.

There is no reason to deny this request since there are about 1000 competitors in the long distance market.

The Telecommunications Division (TD) recommends that this request for revocation be granted and that Gens Telesis International, Inc. Utility Identification Number be

cancelled when the NDIEC certificate is the only one held by the company. Our records show that all surcharges have been paid.

This is an uncontested matter in which the resolution grants the relief requested. Accordingly, pursuant to PU Code Section 311 (g)(2), the 30-day period for public review and comment is being waived.

### **FINDINGS**

1. Gens Telesis International, Inc. was certificated by the Commission as a NDIEC.
2. Gens Telesis International, Inc. requested by letter that its CPCN be revoked.
3. Gens Telesis International, Inc. CPCN should be revoked and its Utility Identification Number should be cancelled since they hold no other CPCN.

### **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:**

1. Gens Telesis International, Inc. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (U-5905-C) is revoked.
2. Gens Telesis International, Inc. Utility Identification Number (U-5905-C) is canceled (since they hold no other CPCN) and will not be reissued.

This Resolution is effective today.
