**Resolution T-17365. Reinstatement of Certificate of Public
Convenience and Necessity Held by X2 Telecom, Inc. (U-7149-C).**

Summary

This Executive Director Resolution reinstates the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) held by X2 Telecom, Inc. (U-7149-C).

Background

X2 Telecom, Inc. was originally licensed as a non-dominant interexchange carrier by D.09-06-022. According to our records, the company was in compliance with the Commission's requirements covering reporting and remittance of Utility Reimbursement Account Fee, Public Purpose Program Surcharges and Performance Bond Filing. However, X2 Telecom, Inc.'s operating authority was inadvertently revoked in Resolution T-17359, adopted April 19, 2012. Communications Division staff was not aware of the mistake until after Resolution T-17359 was adopted.

Discussion

The Communications Division recommends that the CPCN of X2 Telecom, Inc. be reinstated consistent with Rule 16.5 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. X2 Telecom, Inc. was subsequently determined to be fully compliant with the Commission's reporting and remittance requirements. Accordingly, Resolution T-17359's revocation of its operating authority is in error.
