R E S O L U T I O N

**Resolution T-17367. Request for Reinstatement of Certificate
of Public Convenience and Necessity Held by Paxio, Inc.
(U-6850-C).**

Summary

This Resolution reinstates the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) held by Paxio, Inc. (U-6850-C).

Background

On April 19, 2012, the Commission adopted Resolution T-17359 which revoked operating authority for over 100 telephone corporations in default of CPUC surcharge and User Fee reporting and payment requirements pursuant to PU Code Section 401-435, as well as the performance bond filing requirement pursuant Decision (D.) 10-09-017. Paxio, Inc. (Paxio) was revoked for non-compliance with surcharge reporting requirements.

On March 20, 2012, a Notice of Availability was e-mailed to all telecommunications corporations informing these parties that the draft of Resolution T-17359 was available for public comments. Notice of carrier names on this Resolution also appeared on the PUC's Daily Calendar for 30 days. Interested parties were invited to contact Communications Division (CD) staff with questions or written comments on this Resolution. Subsequently, after the Draft Resolution T-17359 was published, 63 telephone companies became 100% compliant with relevant CPUC requirements. The operating authority of the remaining 106 telephone carriers' was revoked when the Commission approved Resolution T-17359 on April 19, 2012.

Discussion

After the draft resolution for Resolution T-17359 was posted, Paxio started reporting its surcharges on April 18th and completed its reporting of surcharges on April 23rd. Paxio has now reported its surcharges through March 2012 and seeks to be reinstated. As Paxio has demonstrated compliance with Commission reporting requirements, CD recommends that Paxio's CPCN (U-6850-C) be reinstated.

Comments on the Draft Resolution

In compliance with PU Code § 311 (g), a Notice of Availability was e-mailed on May 21, 2012 to all telecommunications carriers informing these parties that the draft of this Resolution is available at the Commission's website <http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/> and is available for public comments. In addition, CD informed these parties of the subsequent availability of the conformed resolution, when adopted by the Commission, at the Commission's website as indicated above.

Notice of carrier names on this Resolution also appeared on the PUC's Daily Calendar for 30 days. Interested parties were invited to contact CD staff with questions or written comments on this Resolution.

CD did not receive any comments on draft Resolution T-17367.

Findings

1. Resolution T-17359 revoked the operating authority of Paxio, Inc for non-compliance with the surcharge reporting requirement.
2. Paxio, Inc. has demonstrated its compliance with surcharge reporting requirements by reporting its surcharges through March 2012.
3. Since Paxio, Inc. has now complied with Commission reporting requirements for its surcharges, its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be reinstated.
4. CD did not receive any comments on draft Resolution T-17367.
