RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF THE PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE HELD BY MARTA CADENA AND MARTIN VILLEGAS, DBA MOSQUITO EXPRESS (PSC-10232)

Marta Cadena and Martin Villegas, (Applicants), a partnership, doing business as Mosquito Express, holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-10232). The certificate authorizes Applicants to conduct scheduled services between the cities of Santa Ana, Los Angeles, and Pomona, and the community of San Ysidro.

Marta Cadena, Applicants' Managing Partner, has requested voluntary suspension of Applicants' certificate for a period not to exceed six months. Ms. Cadena indicated that the partnership is experiencing financial problems.

Rail Safety and Carriers Division staff advises that service similar to Applicants' is offered by several other scheduled and on-call PSC operators. Therefore, the public should not be inconvenienced by the suspension.

Most requests for voluntary suspension of a PSC certificate are granted for a period of one year. Pursuant to Applicants' request, we will authorize suspension of service for six months. However, we will also authorize the Rail Safety and Carriers Division to extend the voluntary suspension to as long as one year from the date of this resolution should Applicants find that it needs additional time to resume operations.

This is an uncontested matter in which the resolution grants the relief requested. Accordingly, pursuant to PU Code Section 311 (g)(2), the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment is being waived.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The passenger stage corporation certificate (PSC-10232) held by Marta Cadena and Martin Villegas, (Applicants), is suspended on the effective date of this resolution.
2. During the period of suspension, Applicants shall file reports of gross operating revenue and pay the required fees pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 423.
3. Before resuming operations, Applicants shall make written request for reinstatement of its certificate to the Rail Safety and Carriers Division and comply with General Orders 101-E, 104 and 158-A.
4. Upon Applicants' compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3, the Rail Safety and Carriers Division is authorized to reinstate certificate PSC-10232.
5. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire six months from the effective date of this resolution or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be accomplished through compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 above.
6. Upon written request of Applicants, the Rail Safety and Carriers Division is authorized to extend the period of voluntary suspension to up to one year from the date of this resolution.
