R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-17023. Voluntary revocation of Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity held by fifteen carriers.

Summary

This resolution revokes, at the request of the companies, the Non-Dominant Interexchange Carrier (IER/IEC) and Competitive Local Carrier (CLC/CLR) Certificate of Public Conveniences and Necessity (CPCNs) held by fifteen carriers listed in the Discussion Section below.

Background

The fifteen companies listed in the Discussion Section below were certificated by the Commission in their specified markets. All required tariffs were filed.

Each company has stated in a letter or advice letter to the Commission that it no longer has any customers and that it requests revocation of its CPCN.

Discussion

The companies that would be revoked by this resolution are the following:

Telecommunications Division (TD) recommends that these requests for revocation be granted and that the companies' Utility Identification Numbers be cancelled.

There is no reason to deny this request, since there are about 700 companies currently authorized to perform long distance service and about 300 authorized to perform local service. TD has reviewed the User Fee Surcharge records for the above companies, and it appears that none owes additional surcharges.

This is an uncontested matter in which the resolution grants the relief requested. Accordingly, pursuant to PU Code Section 311 (g)(2), the 30-day period for public review and comment is being waived.

Findings

1. The companies on the above list were certificated by the Commission in the indicated markets.
2. The companies requested by letter or advice letter that their CPCNs be revoked.

3. The companies' CPCNs should be revoked and its Utility Identification Numbers should be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:
