**CPUC DENIES APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING OF
OAKLEY POWER PLANT DECISION**

SAN FRANCISCO, May 26, 2011 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) today in executive session, and with Commissioner Mike Florio abstaining, voted unanimously to make certain minor modifications to its December 2010 decision approving the Oakley Project power plant and deny applications for rehearing.

On December 16, 2010, the CPUC approved Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) purchase and sale agreement with Contra Costa Generating Station LLC for the Oakley Project, a new state-of-the-art natural gas-fired combined cycle facility that is expected to produce 586 megawatts of generation.
