CPUC CONSIDERS ADDING ITEM TO AUGUST 21 MEETING

SAN FRANCISCO, August 14, 2008 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) today said it will consider adding the following item to the closed session Agenda for August 21, 2008, to address the next steps in litigation that have arisen in the context of the recent Court of Appeal decision that must be addressed prior to the next CPUC meeting: Naidu v. CPUC, In the Court of Appeal of the State of California, First Appellate District, Division Five, A119024, A119339, A119947 (decision issued August 8, 2008); Superior Court of the State of California, County of San Francisco, Case No. CGC-05-444782.

This notice is issued pursuant to Government Code Section 11125.3(a)(2), which empowers the CPUC to add late items to its public agenda where “there exists a need to take immediate action and that the need for immediate action came to the attention of the state body subsequent to the agenda being posted...”

The need for this item to be discussed by the CPUC did not become apparent until after the agenda for the August 21, 2008, CPUC meeting had been mailed on August 11, 2008. Action must be taken on the item before the next CPUC meeting in September.
