**CPUC TO HOLD TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS ON POTENTIAL
SALE OF LAKE FOREST UTILITY COMPANY**

These Public Participation Hearings are scheduled to provide the public an opportunity to comment on this request and the CPUC encourages members of the public to attend to express their views. An Administrative Law Judge will listen to public comments and a court reporter will record the comments. Public comments can help the CPUC reach an informed decision. At the Public Participation Hearings the status of the proceeding will be summarized and the CPUC's plans for bringing it to a conclusion will be discussed. The public can comment on all issues involving the applicant's fitness, including the issue of whether the applicant's proposed improvements are adequate, how the competing proposal should be taken into consideration, and the Department of Health's intention to provide Proposition 50 grant funds to assist with the applicant's proposed improvements.
