**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND DIRECTING  
PARTIES TO MAKE FILING**

On May 8, 2003, the Commission issued its Order Instituting Investigation (I.) 03-05-011 to investigate allegations that Bill Dennis and Gloria Dennis a Partnership doing business as Tour Designs (Respondents) had violated numerous sections of the Public Utilities Code and Commission regulations regarding intrastate passenger carrier transportation. In Ordering Paragraph 2 of I.03-05-011, the Commission listed staff's specific allegations and stated that the Respondents would have an opportunity to contest the allegations at an evidentiary hearing. Such a hearing is scheduled for:

The parties are directed to meet and confer regarding the potential for factual and legal stipulations, mutually agreed upon issue statements, lists of

witnesses to be presented at the hearing, and any other preliminary matter that might simplify the hearing.

No later than 12 noon, May 23, 2003, the parties are directed to file and serve, with electronic mail courtesy copies, a document setting forth:

- (1) All factual stipulations;
- (2) Each disputed issue of material fact;
- (3) An outline of the evidence, including witnesses and subject matter, each party expects to present at the hearing; and
- (4) All outstanding legal questions that must be resolved.

Therefore, **IT IS RULED** that an evidentiary hearing will be held at the date and time set out above and the parties shall file and serve the document as described no later than noon, May 23, 2003.
