**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
SETTING SCHEDULING CONFERENCE BY TELEPHONE**

These three applications all seek to have the Commission impose certain operating conditions on the Los Angeles to Pasadena Gold Line, built by the Los Angeles to Pasadena Blue Line Construction Authority and operated by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA). The first application, Application (A.) 02-01-013, filed by the Pasadena Avenue Monterey Road Committee (PAMRC) and subsequently joined by the City of South Pasadena (City), is scheduled for an evidentiary hearing in January 2004. The two later applications by PAMRC and the City, which have been protested by LACMTA, raise issues closely related to the issues in A.03-01-013.

In order to avoid duplication of effort and delay in resolving the important issues raised by the three applications, coordination of the schedules for all three proceedings is required. Since the applicant's opening testimony has already been distributed pursuant to the schedule adopted for A.03-01-013, a scheduling conference should be held promptly.
