**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

This decision also expanded the scope of the subject rulemaking by soliciting further comment on the issues of large utilities (those with over \$1 billion annual operating revenue) reporting holding company executive compensation and reporting compensation and bonuses awarded but not paid in the reporting year.
