**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
REGARDING ADDITIONAL EXHIBIT**

Although the complainants have satisfied their burden of proving that the defendants owe refunds to their tenants, and although they have also caused Pacific Gas and Electric Company to furnish a full account of the gross amount of refunds it made to the defendants, the record is insufficient to render a final decision regarding the amount of refunds that remain unpaid to the tenants. Accordingly, the record will remain open to enable the necessary accounting to be made.

The defendants shall, within 20 days of this ruling, serve on the complainants and the administrative law judge, a final accounting of the amount of refunds they received during calendar years 2001 through 2004 which remain

unpaid and owed to past and present tenants. The amount(s) of these refunds shall be established from the books of account kept by defendants' agent, Park Billing Co.

Complainants shall, within 10 days of receipt of this final accounting, serve on the defendants and the administrative law judge any objections they may have concerning the completeness and accuracy of the accounting.

These documents will be received for the record and, unless the administrative law judge rules otherwise, the matter will be submitted as of the date of receipt of complainants' objections or the expiration of the 10 days allowed for service thereof.
