**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E), Southern California Edison (SCE), California Cable and Telecommunications Association (CCTA) and Current Communications (Current) filed a joint motion requesting a 20-day extension of time to file reply comments in this proceeding. The Utility Reform Network (TURN) supports the joint motion, and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) opposes the motion. We grant a seven-day extension.

We previously granted a request by TURN to extend the deadline for filing comments in this proceeding, resulting in opening comments being due on Thursday, November 3, 2005, and reply comments due on Tuesday, November 15, 2005, with requests for evidentiary hearings also due on November 15, 2005.

The joint motion notes that numerous parties submitted opening comments, and that there were some minor problems with electronic service of

the opening comments.<sup>1</sup> Given these factors, it is reasonable to extend the deadline for filing of reply comments somewhat, but a 20-day extension appears to be unnecessary. Accordingly, the deadline for filing reply comments is extended seven days to November 22, 2005. Requests for evidentiary hearings should be made concurrently with the reply comments, as described in the previous ALJ Ruling Granting Extension of Time.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. Reply Comments are now due on November 22, 2005.
2. Requests for evidentiary hearings are now due on November 22, 2005.
