FORMAT REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTRONIC SPREADSHEETS**

All parties and agency staff are directed to adhere to the following requirements when submitting electronic (e.g., Excel) spreadsheets:

- Each worksheet (tab) must be formatted for printing so that it does not exceed one 8 ½" by 11" page (either portrait or landscape).

- If the spreadsheet that the party or agency staff has compiled is longer than a single page, it must be broken down into separate one-page worksheets (tabs), with clear headings and page numbers for printing.
