**Summary:** On November 29, 2005, John P. Hughes, Regulatory Operations Manager of Southern California Edison Company (SCE), met with Robert Lane, advisor to Cmmr. Bohn, in San Francisco. Also present was Stephen St. Marie, advisor to Cmmr. Bohn. Written material (attached to the notice) was used. Hughes stated that in SCE's 2003 general rate case (GRC), the Commission had approved a Post Test Year Ratemaking mechanism that reflected SCE's capital budget for years 2004-2005 and that included a one-way balancing account. Hughes suggested that the Commission should continue with this mechanism for the 2006 GRC rate cycle. Hughes explained that SCE's Results Sharing program is a form of incentive compensation for its employees. Lastly, Hughes addressed depreciation rates. Hughes stated that the currently adopted rates are outdated and do not reflect appropriate removal costs for assets that are being replaced.
