(Respondent) of Third-Party Verification Citation Forfeiture No. 102 issued by the Consumer Protection and Safety Division pursuant to Resolutions UEB-001. The Citation Forfeiture alleges that Respondent failed to comply with Public Utilities Code Section 2889.5.
Based on the evidentiary record, we find that Respondent failed to confirm that the customer wanted to switch carriers. As such, Citation Forfeiture No. 102 is affirmed.

**Draft Resolution Extending Authority for Vessel Common Carriers to Adjust Fares and Rates Available
for Public Review and Comment**

A Draft **Resolution (TL-19092)** of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD) that extends for one year the authority granted to vessel common carriers by Resolutions TL-19042, TL-19051, TL-19066, and TL-19080 to adjust their passenger fares and freight rates without specific Commission authorization within a "zone of reasonableness" that has an upper limit of 20% above authorized base fares and rates will be on the November 16, 2007 Commission meeting agenda. The Commission may vote on this resolution at that time, or it may postpone a vote until later. When the Commission votes on Resolution TL-19092, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution.
