The purpose of this meeting is to provide parties an opportunity to participate in a forum to discuss various topics related to the monitoring and evaluation of the Consumer Protection Initiative's consumer education program. In Decision 06-03-013, the Commission staff was directed to develop a program to monitor and evaluate the consumer education programs for effectiveness. The staff was directed to "develop a collaborative forum [to] contemplate various options and create a program based on its review of different monitoring and evaluation features." In this regard, the Commission has contracted with a professional program evaluation consultant to carry out the evaluation consistent with the decision. This meeting will introduce the consultant, from the Evaluation and Training Institute (ETI), who will introduce the topic, their contracted evaluation proposal, and their plan for collaboration. Parties who would like, at this meeting or later, to participate in discussing various evaluation topics, such as consumer education needs and evaluation design and implementation, may wish to attend.
