ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SEEKING POST-WORKSHOP COMMENTS ON APRIL 25, 2014 PROPOSAL FOR DETERMINATION OF MARGINAL WATER SUPPLY FOR USE IN EMBEDDED ENERGY COST CALCULATOR

This ruling requests comments in response to the April 25, 2014 workshop that Commission Staff held in the above-captioned proceeding.

In this proceeding, we are, among other things, to "consider appropriate methods for calculating energy savings and cost-effectiveness in the waterenergy context."¹ As part of this consideration we are to devise an "appropriate methodology for determining the energy embedded in water."²

On April 25, 2014, Commission Staff hosted a workshop concerning how to determine the energy embedded in water. Commission Staff has prepared a report on that workshop, and that report is appended here. By this ruling, we seek comments on the workshop and the report. Commenters may be as general
