## ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING WORKSHOP ON DEFINING AND DEVELOPING ALTERNATIVE PROPOSALS FOR DISADVANTAGED COMMUNITIES PURSUANT TO ASSEMBLY BILL 327

As part of work on developing a successor standard tariff or contract that includes "specific alternatives designed for growth [of customer-sited renewable distributed generation] among residential customers in disadvantaged communities," Energy Division staff will hold a public workshop to discuss defining and developing proposals for such alternatives.

The workshop will be held Tuesday, April 7, 2015 in the Commission Auditorium at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102. The workshop will begin at 9:30 a.m. and is scheduled to conclude at 4:30 p.m.
