ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ALLOWING COMMENTS ON THE SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT DIVISION'S RISK ASSESSMENT AND SAFETY ADVISORY SECTION EVALUATION OF THE JOINT UTILITY PROPOSAL AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

Background

This proceeding was initiated by Senate Bill 699¹ which mandated that the Commission develop rules for addressing physical security risks to the distribution systems of electrical corporations with Public Utilities Code Section 364 (Phase I) and to establish standards for disaster and emergency preparedness plans for electrical corporations and regulated water companies consistent with Public Utilities Code Section 768.6 (Phase II).
