In the Matter of the Application of CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U60W), a California corporation, for an order (1) authorizing it to increase rates for water service by \$50,673,500 or 7.6% in test year 2020, (2) authorizing it to increase rates on January 1, 2021 by \$31,461,900 or 4.4% and on January 1, 2022 \$33,000,700 or 4.4% in accordance with the Rate Case Plan, and (3) adopting other related rulings and relief necessary to implement the Commission’s ratemaking policies.

**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES’ RULING NOTICING  
PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARING IN SAN CARLOS**

This ruling schedules a public participation hearing (PPH) in San Carlos, California to provide an opportunity for customers of the Applicant California Water Service Company (CalWater) to communicate directly with the Commission regarding the CalWater General Rate Case application captioned above.

CalWater shall provide public notice of this PPH in accordance with the ordering paragraph below. The date, time and location for the PPH are hereby scheduled, as set forth below.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. A public participation hearing will be held in proceeding Application 18-07-001, and is scheduled, as follows, in the San Carlos service territory of CalWater:

2. CalWater shall prepare a single bill insert notice or separate mailing notice informing its San Carlos customers of the public participation hearing in the San Carlos water district. CalWater shall prepare and provide the draft notice to the Commission's Public Advisor's Office in San Francisco on or before January 21, 2019.<sup>1</sup> The draft notice shall provide language to inform CalWater's customers in San Carlos about the PPH in their district, the purpose of the PPH, a summary of the specific relief that CalWater is requesting in the proceeding, and the date, time and location of the PPH in San Carlos. The Public Advisor's Office may alter or require changes to the notices/bill inserts as it deems necessary.

3. In addition to the requirements set forth above in numbered paragraphs 1 and 2, CalWater shall, with respect to the PPH in San Carlos, also fulfill all the requirements set forth in paragraphs 3 through 7 of the Administrative Law Judges' Ruling Noticing Public Participation Hearings, dated and filed December 18, 2018.
