**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

1. The Prehearing Conference

2. Prehearing conferences in three related but unconsolidated proceedings (A.18-11-015, A.18-11-016 and A.18-11-017) will be heard consecutively beginning at 10:00 a.m.

3. The parties are advised that if they are unable to resolve any discovery disputes, they may tender such disputes to the Commission pursuant to Resolution ALJ-164 and Rule 11.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
