ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING AND NOTICE OF AUGUST 7 AND AUGUST 8, 2019 INFORMATION AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARINGS

This Ruling serves as notice for the public participation hearings (PPH) set in Application (A.) 18-07-013 and A.18-12-008. Two PPHs will be held: the first one at **6:00 p.m. on August 7, 2019**; and the second at **11:00 a.m. on August 8, 2019**. In addition to the PPHs there will also be two **information hearings**; the first one will be held at **5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2019** and the second at **10:00 a.m. on August 8, 2019**. The location for both information hearings and PPHs is as follows:

The purpose of the information hearing is to provide an overview of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) current nuclear decommissioning triennial proceeding (NDCTP), and the issues to be addressed in this proceeding. The information hearing is not a time for parties to argue their positions. The purpose of the information hearing is to provide information that will assist the

public in understanding the proceeding and the decommissioning process. The following agenda is proposed for the information hearings.

- 1. Introduction and purpose of information hearing. (5 minutes) (ALJ and Commissioner);
- 2. PG&E presentation overview of decommissioning and requests made in A.18-12-008 and A.18-07-013. (10 minutes);
- 3. The Commission's Public Advocates Office presentation of role of Public Advocates Office. (5 minutes);
- 4. Intervenors presentation on proceeding issues. (15 minutes);
- 5. Opportunity for Diablo Canyon Independent Safety Committee (DCISC) and Diablo Canyon Engagement Panel (Engagement Panel) to provide brief overview of their mission and role as to Diablo Canyon Power Plant. (10 minutes); and
- 6. Conclusion (ALJ and Commissioner). (5 minutes).

Parties may provide comment and proposed additions or deletions to the above proposed agenda no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 21, 2019.

Draft proposed presentations are to be served on the service list in this proceeding no later than July 24, 2019. Final presentations will be approved through a ruling of the assigned Administrative Law Judge.

PG&E shall ensure that the DCISC and the Engagement Panel are informed that each may participate in the information hearings at each's discretion. The California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) assigned Energy Division Staff is also directed to contact both the DCISC and the Engagement Panel to determine if they intend to participate in the information hearings and PPHs. PG&E shall ensure any proposed presentations for the information hearings by DCISC or the Engagement Plan are included in the July 24, 2019 service of information hearing materials.

PG&E is to notice the information hearings and PPHs, as well as provide relevant information for the information hearings and PPHs, including date, time, location, and purpose of hearings on its website homepage in a location easily accessible to ratepayers. PG&E is to work with the Commission's Public Advisor's Office to finalize proper notice of these hearings to its ratepayers.

IT IS RULED that:

- 1. Information hearings for Application (A.) 18-07-013 and A.18-12-008 will be held at 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2019 and 10:00 a.m. on August 8, 2019.
- 2. Public Participation hearings for Application (A.) 18-07-013 and A.18-12-008 will be held at 6:00 p.m. on August 7, 2019 and 11:00 a.m. on August 8, 2019.
- 3. Parties shall provide comments and suggested edits to the proposed agenda no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 21, 2019.
- 4. Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall collect and provide to the service list proposed presentation materials including PowerPoints and any handouts no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 24, 2019.
- 5. Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall work with the Commission's Public Advisor's Office to finalize proper notice of the information hearings and public participation hearings to ratepayers, as well as post information concerning these hearings consistent with this ruling on its homepage in a location easily accessible to ratepayers.
- 6. Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and Commission Energy Division staff shall contact the Diablo Canyon Independent Safety Committee (DCISC) and the Diablo Canyon Engagement Panel (Engagement Panel) to determine if either or both entities intend to participate in the information

hearing presentations. PG&E shall ensure any proposed presentations for the information hearings by DCISC or the Engagement Panel are included in the July 24, 2019 service of information hearing materials.

7. Final presentations shall be approved through a separate ruling of the assigned Administrative Law Judge.
