The 2:28 PM email ruling did not include the email request from Community Union, Inc. This email ruling includes Community Union, Inc.'s request for an extension and supersedes the 2:48 PM email ruling.

On September 25, 2020, the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Giving Notice of Intent to Take Judicial Notice and Request for Comments. Opening comments were due on October 2, 2020. Reply comments were due on October 9, 2020.

On Friday, October 9, 2020 at 4:12 PM, Community Union, Inc. (Community Union) requested an extension of three hours to tender for filing its reply comments.

Pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 11.6, the party requesting the extension must first make a good-faith effort to ask such parties to agree to the extension. The party requesting thee extension must report the results of this effort when it makes its request. Community Union does not report any efforts to ask the other party in the proceeding to agree. Instead Community Union cites to technical difficulties.

Community Union's request is granted. The other party in the proceeding, the Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED), will not be prejudiced. Because Community Union did not file opening comments, CPED did not file reply comments, as there is nothing for CPED to respond to. On the other hand, CPED filed opening comments, and now Community Union seeks permission to late file its reply comments in order to respond to CPED.

Community Union's reply can be accepted as late filed on Monday, October 12, 2020. Pursuant to Rule 11.6, Community Union must state in the opening paragraph of the reply that the ALJ has granted the extension on this specific date.
