To The Parties on the Service List in Proceeding C. 20-08-003:

On December 10, 2020, Complainant in this proceeding Utility Telecom Group, LLC filed a Response to the motion of Defendant Bandwidth.Com CLEC, LLC. The initial motion sought dismissal of the Complaint, alleging that the Defendant was not being accused of violation of any applicable laws relating to telephone number porting. In addition to other issues, Complainant's Response alleges that the Defendant has violated federal and Commission rules and orders relating to its refusal to port the telephone numbers at issue and that dismissal of the Complaint is therefore not justified. The below request by the Defendant to file a reply to the issues raised in the Response is granted. Pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, such reply shall be due December 21, 2020.
