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Subject: I.17-02-002: Email Ruling Providing Notice of Interagency Workshop on July 9, 2021

On July 9, 2021, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and the California Energy Commission (CEC) will co-host a workshop discussion as part of the CEC's 2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) Update docket # 21-IEPR-01. This discussion will address the local electricity reliability impacts of reducing or eliminating Southern California Gas Company's Aliso Canyon Natural Gas Storage Facility (Aliso Canyon). The goal of this discussion, which will take place the afternoon of July 9, is twofold: first, to understand existing analyses within and outside of this proceeding, how they align and whether there are any analytical gaps, and the expected local reliability shortfall if the use of Aliso Canyon is reduced or eliminated; and second, the next steps to address any gaps between existing analyses in this proceeding.

The workshop will take place on July 9, 2021, from approximately 2:00 – 5:00 PM. The workshop will be remote participation only, and participation information (links, registration information, phone access) will be provided when available via email ruling.

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Please note that decisionmakers will be present at this workshop, but no action will be taken. Information and materials from this workshop may be entered into the record of this proceeding, and a future ruling will provide more details and instructions to that end.
