ALJ Lau and the Service List of A.21-03-008,

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and the Joint Community Choice Aggregators (JCCAs) have resolved their disputed facts through subsequent data requests and an informal agreement to stipulate to the admission of certain exhibits into the record, and hearings are no longer needed. PG&E and the Public Advocates Office did not have any disputed facts that required hearings. Accordingly, PG&E respectfully requests that hearings be cancelled.

There remains a few limited disputed issues of law that will require briefing. In the coming days and weeks, PG&E will work with the parties to:

- File a Joint Motion to admit exhibits to the record, including the stipulated exhibits discussed above (with a motion by PG&E to file under seal the confidential exhibits);
- Notice a settlement conference; and if all parties agree, file a Joint Motion for Adoption of a Settlement Agreement; and
- Inform the ALJ and parties on which outstanding legal questions that are not addressed in the settlement agreement and will be briefed.
