To the Parties:

This email ruling orders San Diego Community Power and the California Public Utilities Commission's Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division to file and serve Responses addressing the matters below. The Responses must be clearly formatted so that they indicate which matter is being addressed.

1. List all facts in the compliance filing that are in dispute.
2. List all facts in the citation appeal that are in dispute.
3. State whether evidentiary hearings are needed and, if so, list all disputed material issues of fact to be addressed at evidentiary hearings.
4. State whether the responding party would like to pursue alternative dispute resolution.
5. State whether the responding party intends to make discovery requests and, if so, provide a suggested timeline for requests and responses.
6. Propose a schedule for briefs, prepared testimony, and any other events.

The Responses are due on December 30, 2021.
