**Subject:** C.20-04-007 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RULING SETTING FURTHER SIX-MONTH STAY OF PROCEEDING AND DIRECTING 60-DAY JOINT STATUS STATEMENTS

To The Service List For C.20-04-007:

On January 13, 2022, in accordance with the July 13, 2021, Ruling granting the parties' jointly request for a six-month stay of this proceeding's calendar of events in order to pursue their agreement to proceed with a joint investigation regarding the Santanna Main, the parties filed a Joint Statement requesting a further six-month stay in order to enable further joint investigation and engage in settlement discussions.

For good cause showing, this proceeding's calendar of events is stayed for a further six-month period, to July 13, 2022. Parties are directed to file joint status statements every 60 days regarding the status of the joint investigation and regarding the status of their settlement discussions: to wit, on March 14, 2022, May 13, 2022, and July 13, 2022. The July 13, 2022, joint status statement must also include a report regarding the final status of the joint investigation and a proposed schedule for a prompt return to the proceeding's stayed calendar of events or a proposed schedule for an alternative calendar of events for this proceeding (ex: the prompt service of exhibits and testimony in lieu of an evidentiary hearing).

The Commission will timely issue an Order to avoid this stay from violating the proceeding's current April 1, 2022, statutory deadline.
