**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
GRANTING MOTION OF JOINT APPLICANTS FOR
AN EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF
DOCUMENTS PREVIOUSLY FILED UNDER SEAL**

On July 25, 2018, I granted motions of Wild Goose Storage, LLC and Lodi Gas Storage, L.L.C. (hereafter referred to as the "Joint Applicants") for Leave to File Under Seal and maintain the confidentiality of certain materials described with particularity in the motions. My rulings ordered that the described materials be kept sealed for a period of three years.

On July 23, 2021, Joint Applicants filed a joint motion requesting a three-year extension of the confidential status granted in my prior rulings. The motion is unopposed.

IT IS RULED that:

1. The “Motion of the Joint Applicants Requesting a 3-Year Extension of Confidential Status Granted in the Administrative Law Judge’s Prior Rulings” dated July 23, 2021, is granted.

2. The confidential information will remain under seal for a period of three years after the date of this order. During this three-year period, this information will remain under seal and may not be viewed by any person other than the assigned Commissioner, the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), the Assistant Chief ALJ, or the Chief ALJ, except as agreed to in writing or as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction.
