Subject: A.21-10-005: Email Ruling Granting Motion for Suspension of Procedural Schedule

On January 25, 2022, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed a motion for immediate suspension of the procedural schedule. SCE intends to file a notice detailing how new requirements adopted by the South Coast Air Quality Management District impact the timing and scope of SCE's proposed project. SCE states a suspension is warranted so parties can focus on discussions regarding these changes, instead of preparing for testimony and hearings under the current schedule. SCE indicates the other parties to the proceeding support the suspension.

Good cause being demonstrated, SCE's motion for immediate suspension of the procedural schedule is granted. A revised schedule will be established after SCE files its notice regarding the changes to the timing and scope of its proposed project.
